Water Savings

237,990,000 L

This is equivalent to the population of Australia (25.5 million) drinking
9 x 1 Litre bottles of water each or taking 1,189,950 baths.



Greenhouse Gas Savings

157,779 kg

This is equivalent to taking 202 cars off Australian roads for 1 year.



Electricity Savings

64,798 kWh

This equivalent to powering 8,765 Australian homes for 1 day.



11,072* items

70% of items that were collected were
rehomed in communities that needed them most.

The remaining items are either recycled into wiper rags (18%) or converted into
a biofuel (6%) which is an alternative fuel used in the cement kilns, saving finite fossil
fuels such as gas or coal. Only 6% of items cannot be reused or recycled and goes to waste.

*On average 1 kg of clothing = 37 items.



**This sustainability report assumes that what is collected is 100% cotton. As clothing can be made from many
different fibres, including manmade fibres which consume more resources. The above figures are a conservative
representation of environmental savings.*
